General Tips and Recommendations

1- An IS elective course includes any course taught in the Social Science Department without a POL/GOV code. Acceptable codes include ECO, GEO, HST, IR, IST, PHI, and REL. Chair's approval needed for LIT courses.

2- International Studies students may elect to take ECO 220 and ECO 221 instead of ECO 210. In this case, ECO 221 replaces one IS 300-level elective.

3- Any other for-credit MTH course except MTH 100 can substitute for MTH 112.

4- Engineering Statistics may substitute for STT 201.
