2025-2026 Tuition Payment Calendar - Academic Preparatory Program (APP)

Admitted students, AY24 and onwards

October 01, 2025

Starting from Fall 2023, new students will be required to pay 50% of the tuition fee for their first semester before signing the enrollment contract and officially becoming AUIS students. Subsequently, for each subsequent semester, students must make a payment of 50% of the tuition two weeks prior to the start of that term to gain access to their classes.

Returnee students, admitted to AUIS prior Fall 2023:

Enrolled students will receive an invoice through their AUIS email accounts. This process will take place after the first week of classes in the term for the Academic Preparatory Program ("APP"). The payment due date will be the last day of the fourth week of classes no later than 05:00 pm, as the date clearly marked in the Academic Calendar.

Note:

Failure to meet these payment deadlines will result in a financial hold being placed on the student's SONIS account. Students will face several restrictions, including but not limited to the inability to add courses, register for upcoming semesters, being dropped from their enrolled courses, and accessing final grades.
